## 2022 Annual Meeting Minutes December 3, 2022

- 0900 Current Committee Members present: DeArman, Molloy, Lucas, Rysewyk, and Open Position
- 0910 Lucas calls meeting to order and gives brief introduction
- Nominees for 3 open Committee Positions, all nominations had secondary motion of nomination Candidates: Molloy, Alarcon, Rysewyk, and Wagner
- O920 Candidate introductions, each candidate given up to 5 minutes
- 0930 Community voting for new Committee Members conducted (Sherri Simmons and Laura Ruiz volunteered to count votes)
- 0945 Project updates: Molloy
  - Culvert projects-installation of Qty. 3-18" culverts (2-Lost Horizon, 1- Rancho Heights Road/Lost Horizon) Estimate Private Contractor \$45,000, RHR&MC cost- Approx. \$4,500 for all 3 culverts
  - Cameras at Gate update- Completion by January 2023 estimated cost \$2,800
    D Savage commented: Who will have camera access- RHR&MC Members and will be accessed only as needed; Secondary gate for entry- Glasgow suggested sub-group to research, also concerns on increase cost of repair and maint.

  - Rancho Heights Community vehicle sticker-Reconsider a vehicle sticker to help identify Rancho Heights Community Residents, Committee to revisit next year

  - Traffic advisory- Please be courteous to neighbors and keep road speeds slow to preserve road surfaces and prevent accidents
- Sherri Simmons- mountain lion presentation and raffle- All Community encouraged to contact Sherri with any mountain lion sightings, Lucas commented on predatory preventative measures
