Last Year's project updates:

2 - Culverts installed at Rancho Heights Road/Hidden Oaks Road

Installation of Stop signs at Rancho Heights/Magee, Pala Temecula Rd./Rancho Heights- It was asked if we could look into installing a stop sign on the downhill side of Magee at the "Y"- not feasible, too much road damage

Temporary and permanent road reflectors install

Roadside brush management- The community was very pleased with the brush management that is taking place in the community and agrees that we should continue on Magee RD.

Out of defined Community boundary access overview- introduced our new neighbors Degoede Family and discussed the easement to their property. Discussed the Miner property in the back of the community, and his access through the community.

Previous culvert installation effectiveness-Community members that were present and effected by the culverts had nothing but positive feedback.

Next year's Projects:

Culvert at Rancho Heights Road/Sunset Peak- Community agreed that this is needed

Improve roadside drainage

Gate keypad upgrade-the community overwhelming agreed that we need to update the system and like the possibility of adding a system with a camera. Security is again one of the most talked about topics to include spikes at the gate.

Bulletin Board upgrade- we discussed the option of making one for the community to use for items like eggs etc. and a new one for the Committee info.

Limited road repairs in anticipation of SDG&E major road construction-All were in agreeance with waiting until the work is complete Identify parcels with easement access and offer integration into Community Road Assessment-Sonny spoke to this and is working on identifying these parcels
